FUTURE AGENTS CYBER BRIEF

HUDtech, founded in 2028, developed the first fully integrated augmented reality device to coincide with society's everyday life. The HUDset, released to the public in January 2033, is predicted to soon become accessible to all demographics within the United States by the end of 2033.

FA conducted vulnerability assessments/authorized hacking operations on the HUDset in February 2033 using a combination of commercial and government tools. In the operations, FA continues to find routinely that basic cyber security "best practices" have been implemented to the best of its ability.

Rare vulnerabilities have been documented and assessed to have been associated with user fault, including but not limited to:

- Poor upkeep
 - Failing to update software
- Damaged Hardware
